

RV CONSIGNMENT WHAT TO BRING



1. Make sure that the RV is very clean (inside and out), including the roof, awning, storage compartments, wheels, and tires and everywhere inside and remove all of your items and garbage. If your RV is not in a clean and satisfactory condition inside and out, we will need to provide cleaning services for you to prepare it for our consignment program, and the service fees will be deducted from your net profit.
2. Check to be sure that all of the black and gray water tanks are empty, and the black tank has fresh chemicals in the tank. If they are not empty, we will have to empty them for you, and the service fees will be deducted from your net profit.
3. Check to be sure the LP tank(s) are full. Otherwise, we will have to fill them to do an inspection, which will be deducted from your net profit.
4. Make sure the fuel tank is full before entering our lot. Otherwise, we will have to fill it, which will be deducted from your net profit.
5. Items to leave with the RV (if you already have them), which will add value to your RV and are great selling points: complete hitch Package (for Travel Trailers and Fifth Wheels); wheel chocks; tongue lock w/key (for Travel Trailers); stabilizer jack crank handle (for Travel trailer and fifth wheels); original comforter for the master bed and any other mattress covers that came on any beds; remote controls for any TV's, DVD players, stereos, power awnings, power stabilizer jacks; original curtains; any one-ply toilet paper or holding tank chemicals that you may have leftover; awning rod (for manual awnings); electrical adapters (15, 30 or 50 amp); electrical extension cord (30 or 50 amp); power cord to RV; sewer hose & any sewer hose attachments; freshwater hose; entrance rug; or any RV accessories or items that you wish to leave with the RV.
6. Items to bring to us on the day you bring the RV: RV tag & registration form (we will need to make a copy), clear title (or copy of the title, front and back - if the RV is paid off), RV insurance ID card and declarations page (we need a copy of each), all sets of keys for the engine, storage compartments, entrance door, dead-bolts, tongue lock (for travel trailers) - at least one full set; 2 sets is preferred.
7. If you still owe on your RV, be sure to have the loan company name, full address, phone number, and loan number to fill out on the consignment agreement.
